Itinary

Day 1: Arrive Delhi Airport, Transfer to Hotel. Delhi, Capital of modern India is the the third largest city with New Delhi created in 1911 by the British and Old Delhi by the Muslims in 17th and 19th centuries Delhi has seen the rise and fall of many Emperors,,which has left behind.a plethora of monuments that commemorate the grandeur and glory of bygone ages. Overnight Delhi

Day 2: Full Day Sightseeing Tour of Delhi. Highlights - Visit to Jama Masjid (largest Mosque in India),Tour of Chandni Chowk (Silver Street) on board your cylice rickshaw, Photo stop at the Red Fort and the India Gate (in honour of the martyred soldiers) Drive past the Parliament and the Presidents House and dis embark at RajGhat (a Memorial to Mahatma Ghandhi) Lastly vist to Qutub Minar, a World Heritage site (B). Optional - Evening enjoy dinner followed by sound and light show at the Red Fort (Lal Quila)

Day 3: Delhi - Agra .by surface - 210 km / 4 hours
Post breakfast drive to Agra ..Overnight Agra (B). Taj Mahal - A shrine reminding the World of undying love , displaying Islamic Architecture in its purest form with passages from the Holy Book.The tomb is encased in white marble and below the tomb lie the mortal remains of Shahjahan and his beloved wife Mumtaz. The Taj is situated on the banks of River Yamuna and enclosed in a garden amongst flowers and fountains. The construction of the Taj took 22 years to complete. Optional - Evening enjoy Mohabbat e Taj Show depicting the saga of love, followed by dinner

Day 4 - Visit to Taj . Agra - Jaipur by surface 236 km
Morning visit this extraordinary monument by the first light of the day creating an unforgettable memory. Return to the hotel on a Horse Carriage ride for breakfast. After breakfast checkout and drive to Jaipur.Enroute Visit Fatehpur Sikri.- A World Heritage Site . Continue to Jaipur, Capital of Rajasthan (B,)

Day 5: Jaipur. Full Day Sightseeing Tour of Jaipur Highlights - Hawa Mahal Jantar Mantar Observatory, City Palace ,with its exquisite gardens and Amber Fort where you will enjoy an Elephant ride (B). Optional - Evening enjoy dinner at a local restaurant followed by traditional folk dance performance

Day 6 - Jaipur - Mumbai by flight (inc) Remainder of the day at leisure to enjoy your time on Juhu Beach (B) Mumbai,formerly known as Bombay the Commercial Capital of India is known as the city that never sleep. Mumbai is a potpouri of cultures, customs and lifestyles.

Day 7 - Mumbai - Full Day City Tour Highlights - am Visit Elephanta Caves, by ferry, dating back to the 7th Century Highlights - pm The Prince of Wales Museum ,Victoria Terminus Gateway of India ,Hanging Gardens Kamal Nehru Park, Mani Bhawan where Mahatma Gandhi used to stay, Colourful Crawford Market, haji Ali, and Marine Drive, the most popular seaside promenade (B)
